

Genesis 14 ¹⁹ He blessed him and said,

“Blessed be Abram of God Most High,
Possessor of heaven and earth;
²⁰ And blessed be God Most High,
Who has delivered your enemies into your hand.”

He gave him a tenth of all. ²¹ The king of Sodom said to Abram, “Give the people to me and take the goods for yourself.” ²² Abram said to the king of Sodom, “I have sworn to the Lord God Most High, possessor of heaven and earth, ²³ that I will not take a thread or a sandal thong or anything that is yours, for fear you would say, ‘I have made Abram rich.’

Deut. 32:8 “When the Most High gave the nations their inheritance,
When He separated the sons of man,
He set the boundaries of the peoples
According to the number of the sons of Israel.

Psalm 46:4 There is a river whose streams make glad the city of God,
The holy dwelling places of the Most High.

Psalm 47:2 For the Lord Most High is to be feared,
A great King over all the earth.

Psalm 57:2 I will cry to God Most High,
To God who accomplishes *all things* for me.

Psalm 83:18 That they may know that You alone, whose name is the Lord,
Are the Most High over all the earth.

Hosea 11:7 So My people are bent on turning from Me.
Though they call them to *the One* on high,
None at all exalts *Him*.
